Scope of Change

The Idaho Cleanup Project (ICP) is now operated for the U.S. Department of Energy by Idaho Environmental Coalition, LLC (IEC). Changes in controlled document ownership, applicability, and title references described below are a result of transition activities between Fluor Idaho, LLC and IEC. 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- Management of the Idaho Spent Fuel Facility (ISFF) license (license number SNM-2512).
